The following rules will be Strictly enforced or loose pool privileges:

- . Persons diagnosed with Covid-19 are strictly prohibited to enter the pool area.
- . Persons in contact with anyone with Covid -19 are prohibited from entering the pool area.
- . Persons arriving from International locations identified with warning level 2-3 are strictly prohibited to enter the pool area.

If feeling ill, or if you have a temp over 100 degrees do not enter the pool area.

 All participants will be temperature checked before entering the pool area. Those with a fever will be turned away.

Sign up on line

Residents are required to reserve swim time in advance on Website

Complete online form and check off list

Residents are required to reserve swim time in advance on the Website – in 2-hour intervals. 24 hours' notice is required.

On line forms are to be kept for 6 months and must be surrendered upon demand.

Residents are required to sign a liability waiver

Only single family households not to exceed 6 people may sign up via the HOA website for two hours. 8am to 8pm

Main Pool swimming only. NO SPA. If you use the spa, you will be banned from using the pool until the end of the COVID-19 virus.

No outside guest is allowed at this time.

. One family of 6 members at a time. No letting in your friends and neighbors. They each must reserve their own time on the website and sign a waiver.

No in/out privileges

Use hand sanitizer prior to entering the pool

Use of Face masks encouraged at all times outside the pool.

Maintain 6 feet distance inside the pool area and inside the pools.

Users must clean up after use. Cleaning supplies provided. Before a family leaves the pool area, a pool committee proctor will check the area, including the bathroom. (The residents shall call the pool committee member assigned to their particular 2-hour interval.) The residents must be present for the after-usage inspection. If the area was not properly cleaned and we need to call the cleaning service, you will be charged for this on your monthly condo fee bill. The fee is \$300. If you leave the area without receiving the inspection, your monthly condo fee bill will reflect an additional \$300 cleaning fee.

. No food or beverages in the pool area or you will be banned from using the pool until the end of the COVID-19 virus. You may only bring plastic bottled water.

9. All children under the age of 16 need to be accompanied by an adult resident at all times in the pool area. No kid drop off

Residents are required to bring their own chairs Residents are required to bring their own towels.

Users must clean up after use. Cleaning supplies provide Bathrooms remain **open**. Ask about cleaning crew.

Read signs for how to disinfect the pool area upon entering and exiting.

Employees, Committee Members, & Pool users must use face mask properly, covering the mouth and nose.

Use hand sanitizer then use disinfecting wipes to thoroughly disinfect the pool area:

- . All users need to be listed on the Pool Rental Rules Agreement. These are the people who can come into the pool area during your 2-hour interval. Ask Legal about.
- 11. Once this is signed, the original goes to the assigned proctor before the scheduled 2-hour interval will begin. And a copy goes to the resident. The safe reopening plan will be found on the website.

Wash hands frequently with soap and water.

Failure to comply with any of these rules will risk closure at the pool and / will result in loss of pool privileges.
